

Board of Supervisors Special Meeting held June 29, 2004

A special meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday June 29, 2004 commencing at 1:00 p.m. Chairman Mr. Garris called the meeting to order. Present were Supervisors Mr. Hensel and Mr. Doratt, Mr. Pompo Township Solicitor, Mr. Lowry Township Building Inspector/Zoning Officer, Mr. Dennis O'Neil in place for Mr. MacCombies office and members of the community.

The Board waived the reading of any previous meeting minutes the moment of silence and pledge of allegiance.

Mr. Garris began the meeting by discussing Resolution 2004-05 pertaining to the sewage facilities planning module for the Morris Farm. Mr. Pompo noted that the 30-day comment period, no notice is required but DEP can decide if the comment period is necessary. Mr. Pompo suggested posting the public notice for a 30-day comment period before the modules are sent to DEP. Ms. Boswell an attorney representing Mr. Newton stated she feels safe sending the modules to DEP.

Mr. Garris made a motion, seconded by Mr. Doratt, to adopt Resolution 2004-05 pertaining to the sewage facilities planning module for the Morris Farm. With there being no questions from the public, the Board voting "aye", the motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Garris made a motion, seconded by Mr. Doratt, to give Morris Farm final conditional approval subject to the 6 conditions outlined and a waiver from the Townships subdivision land development section 109.23D regarding cul-de-sacs. With there being no questions from the public, the Board voting "aye", the motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Lowry requested an extension until August 1, 2004 for the adoption of the Statewide building code. The Board granted the request.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
