

Board of Supervisors Special Meeting held Thursday, March 29, 2006

The Board of Supervisors conducted a special meeting held on Thursday, March 29, 2006 commencing at 7:00 p.m. Chairman Hensel called the meeting to order. Present was Supervisor Mr. Doratt, Mr. Pompo Township Solicitor, Mr. Lowry, and Township Engineer, Mr. Wayne Grafton, Township Consultant and members of the community. Supervisor Ms. Silvernail was absent.

The moment of silence and pledge of allegiance were waived.

Mr. Hensel made a motion, seconded by Mr. Doratt to close the Board of Supervisors meeting and open a public hearing regarding Resolution 2006-03, a Resolution Pursuant to Article III, Section 302 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code Adopting the Sadsbury Township comprehensive Plan of 2005. With Mr. Hensel voting "aye" and Mr. Doratt voting "aye", the motion passed.

Mr. Pompo stated that this was an advertised public hearing. It was advertised in the Daily Local News on March 1, 2006 and March 8, 2006. Proper notice was given to the Chester County Planning Commission, the Sadsbury Township Planning Commission. The Comprehensive Plan was submitted to all adjacent municipalities and the Coatesville School District. Mr. Pompo advised the Board of Supervisors they may consider and adopt the Comprehensive Plan at this meeting if that is their desire.

Mr. Grafton thanked all the members of the Comprehensive Plan committee for their hard work on the Plan. Mr. Grafton stated that the Plan was reviewed by the Chester County Planning Commission and some changes were made. He also stated that the Comprehensive Plan has been at the Township Office for public display.

Mr. Hensel made a motion, seconded by Mr. Doratt to adjourn the public hearing and reconvene the Board of Supervisors Meeting.

Mr. Hensel made a motion, seconded by Mr. Doratt to adopt Resolution 2006-03 A Resolution Pursuant to Article III, Section 302 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Adopting the Sadsbury Township Comprehensive Plan of 2005. With Mr. Hensel and Mr. Doratt voting "aye", the motion passed.

Mr. Hensel and Mr. Doratt thanked the Committee members, Ann McGrail, Nancy Keen, Claire Audette, and John Lymberis for volunteering their time to the Township.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
