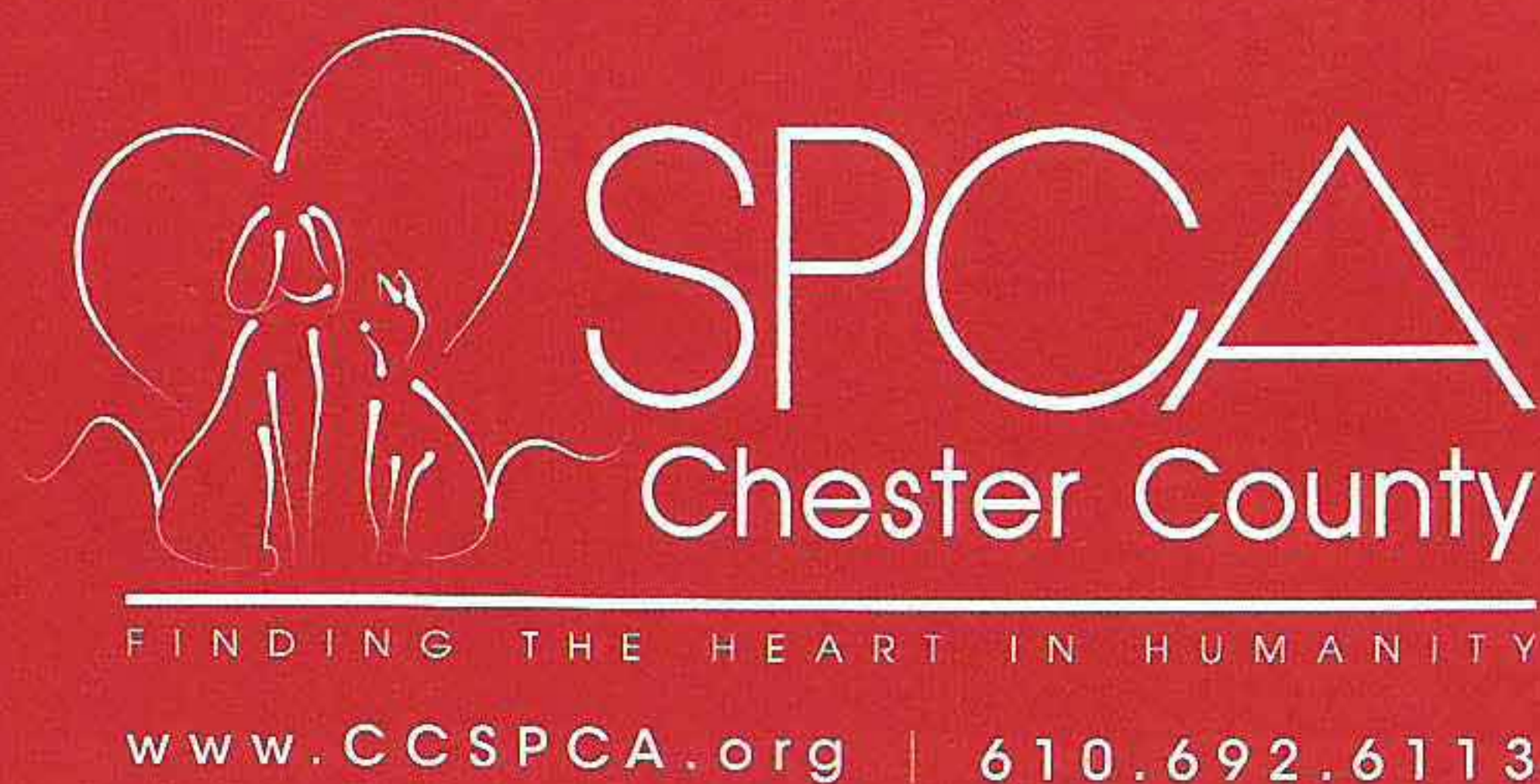

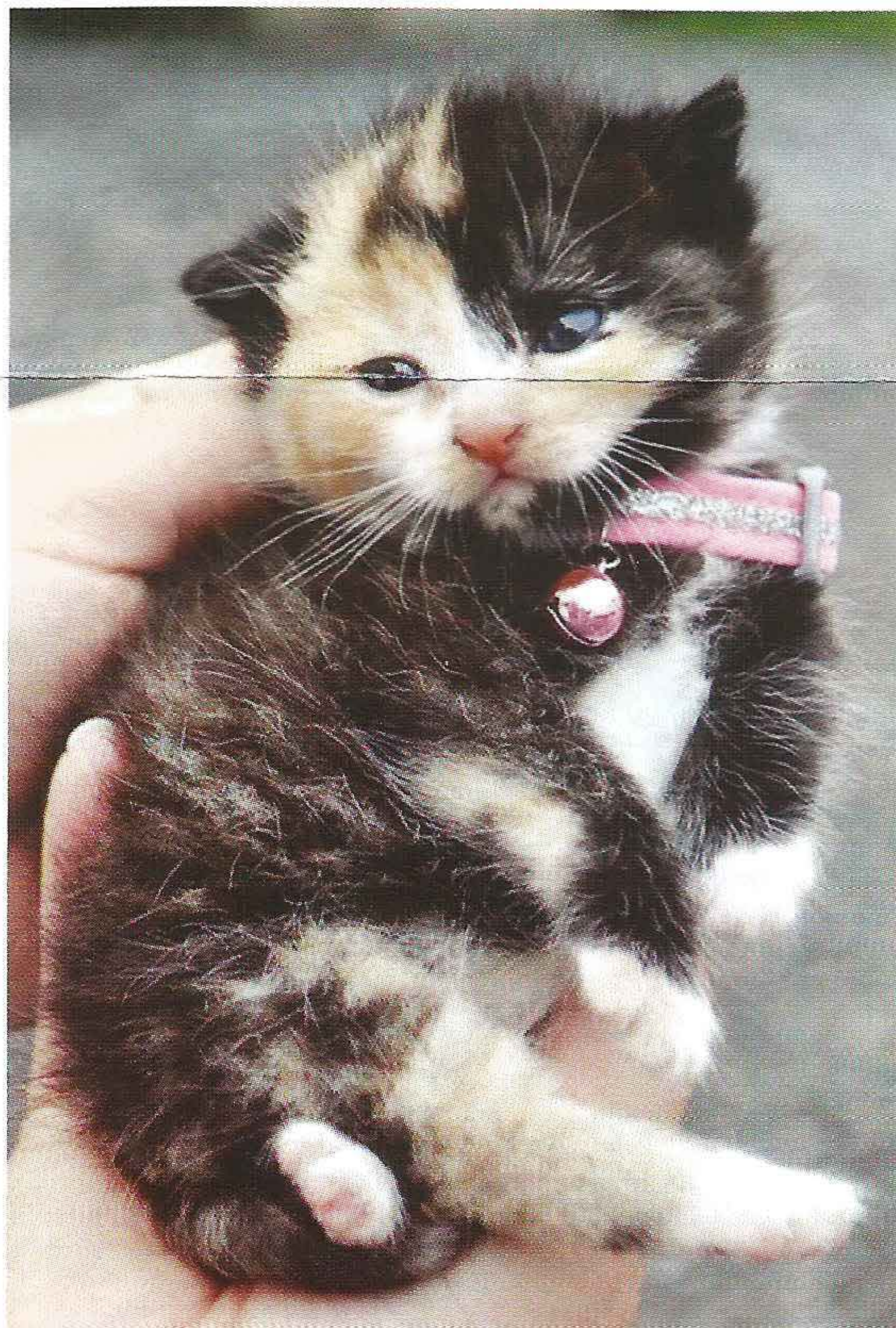

KITTEN SEASON **FOSTER FAMILY PROGRAM**



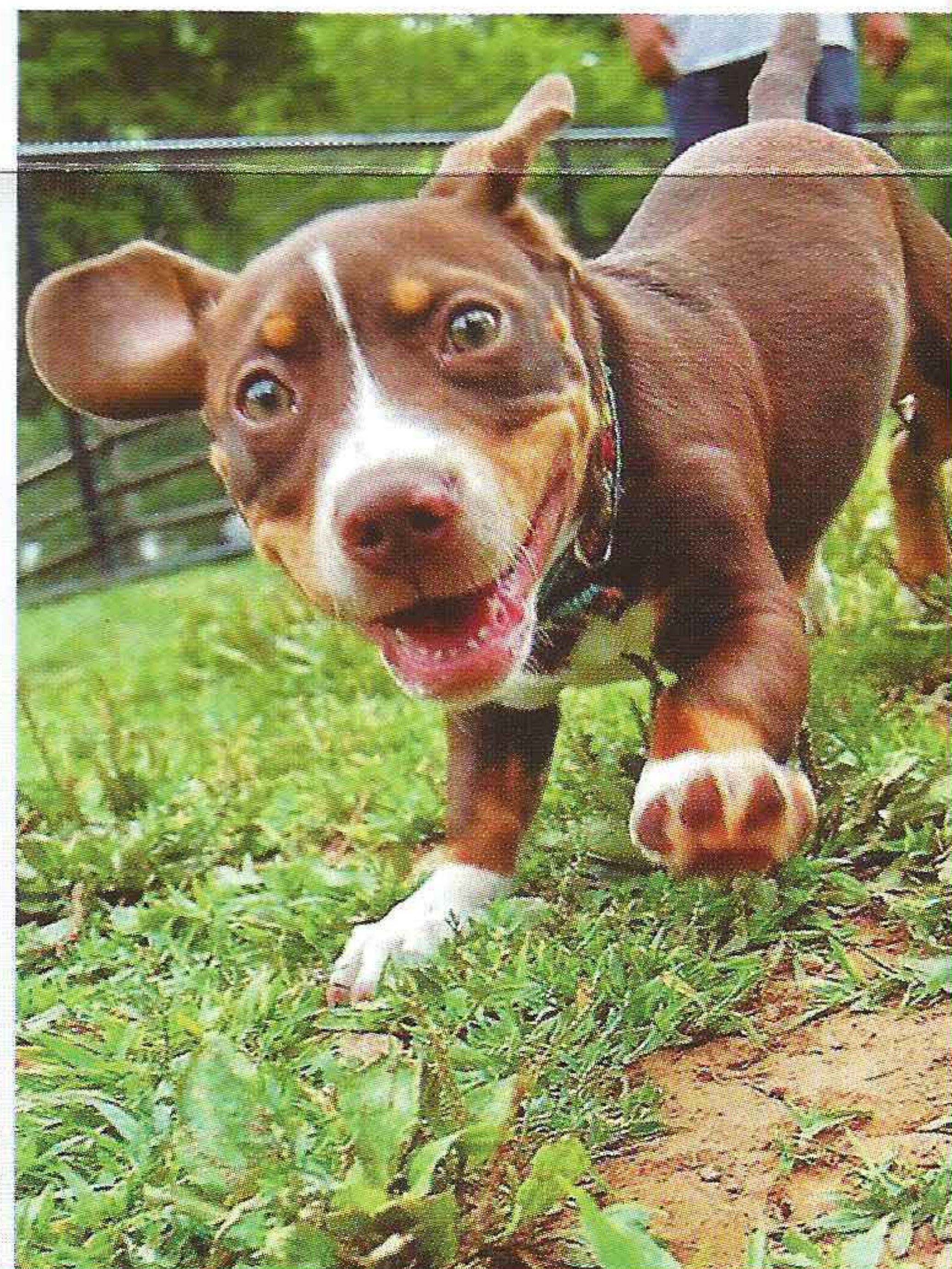
